Introduction: God has a plan. His plan is not random and God's plan is good. God's plan wends its way through all times, all places and all people. Yes, God even has a plan for you! The prophet Jeremiah says it this way: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (Jeremiah 29:11). **Read:** Luke 9:12-17

Discussion:

- 1) There are a lot of hungry people listening to Jesus. What plans for feeding them do the disciples have?
- 2) What is Jesus' plan for feeding the people?
- 3) What part did the disciples have in Jesus's feeding plan? What purposes does the text suggest Jesus has besides simply providing food?
- 4) What plans does Jesus want to involve you and your community in? What would the next logical step toward your involvement be?

Application: Ask God this week to show you what plans he has for you to be involved in.

**Prayer:** Father, thank you for including us in your redemption plans for the world. Show us where we can join into what you are doing around us this week. Amen
