Read: Galatians 6:1-10

Discussion:

- 2. One of the burdens we may carry is error and sin in a friend. What do you need to watch for when correcting someone? What is the goal of correction?
- 3. How are you sharing good things with your Pastors? How are you sharing their load?
- 4. What causes you to feel weary? What help do you receive from Isaiah 40:28-31; 1 Corinthians 15:57-58 and Hebrews 12:1-3?

Application: Talk to God about your burdens and the burdens you are carrying for others. Ask for clarity about what you are doing and how you are doing it.

Prayer: Holy God, thank you forgiving us brothers and sisters in Christ to share life with. Direct us and equip us to live as you want us to. Amen
